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Formation Bridging Program (FBP) 2020

<u>What is FBP?</u>

The Formation Bridging Program (FBP) is usually a week-long set of preparatory courses designed for all new students of the Junior High School Department. FBP aims to introduce the incoming seminarians to the rhythm of seminary life and provide them fundamental skills to respond more fully to the demands of formation.

What is new with FBP 2020?

In response to the Covid-19 Pandemic, FBP 2020 is specially designed to properly orient and prepare incoming seminarians not only with Distance Learning but more importantly on seminary formation at home. This year's FBP is also structured to provide an experience of the actual seminary set-up so that they can bring the experience at home. To limit the exposure of seminarians, the program is reduced to three days.

Transportation

The FBP is a stay-out program. Parents/Guardians are responsible to bring their sons in the morning and fetch them in the afternoon.



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<u>Fees</u>

What to bring?

- 3. Lunch will be prepared by the seminary. But bring your own snacks.

<u>Reminders:</u>

- 1. Be on time. (At least 5-10 minutes before 8:00 AM)
- 2. Attire:
 - a. Day 1 & 2: Casual (Polo shirt, jeans, shoes)
 - b. Day 3: Formal (Long Sleeves, slacks, leather shoes)
- 3. Wear facemasks always.
- 4. Observe physical distancing.
- 5. Bring your own hygiene stuff (alcohol/sanitizer, etc.)
